to the Federal Republic of Germany

Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn will pay a Royal visit to the Federal Republic of Germany from 2nd to 6th of July, B.E. 2558 (2015).

During this visit, Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn will attend the Closing Ceremony of the 65th Lindau Nobel Laureate Meeting on Mainau Island and also grant an audience to the young Thai scientists who participate in the said meeting. Moreover, Her Royal Highness will observe activities and the Open Innovation Space of the Otto Bock HealthCare GmbH in Berlin. Her Royal Highness will also visit places of historical importance such as the Museum Brandhorst, the Rosgartenmuseum, the Archaeological Museum of Baden-Württemberg and the Archive of the Federal Commissioner for the Records of the State Security of the former German Democratic Republic.

Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn will depart from Suvarnabhumi Airport, Samut Prakan Province, on Thursday, 2nd of July, B.E. 2558 (2015) at 00.50 hours (Wednesday night of 1st of July, B.E. 2558) by Thai Airways International Public Company Limited flight number TG 924, and will return by Thai Airways International Public Company Limited flight number TG 921, scheduled to arrive at Suvarnabhumi Airport, Samut Prakan Province, on Monday, 6th of July, B.E. 2558 (2015) at 06.25 hours.
