Concerning the Royal Visits of  
Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn  
to the Swiss Confederation, the Federal Republic of Germany and the United Kingdom

Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn will pay Royal Visits to the Swiss Confederation, the Federal Republic of Germany and the United Kingdom from 17th to 26th of November, B.E. 2558 (2015).

During the visit to the Swiss Confederation, Her Royal Highness will observe activities of the European Organization for Nuclear Research and will also witness the signing of Framework Collaboration Agreement between the Synchrotron Light Research Institute and the European Organization for Nuclear Research.

During the visit to the Federal Republic of Germany, Her Royal Highness will observe activities of the Deutsches Elektronen-Synchrotron and will also witness the signing of Cooperation Agreement between the Deutsches Elektronen-Synchrotron and the National Astronomical Research Institute of Thailand (Public Organization). Moreover, Her Royal Highness will visit some places of importance such as the Museum der Arbeit and the Deutsches Zollmuseum.

During the visit to the United Kingdom, Her Royal Highness will participate in the Thai musical performance in the Celebrations on the Auspicious Occasion of Her Royal Highness' 5th Cycle Birthday Anniversary 2nd April 2015 at the University of London.

Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn will depart from Suvarnabhumi Airport, Samut Prakan Province, on Tuesday, 17th of November, B.E. 2558 (2015) at 00.35 hours (Monday night of 16th of November, B.E. 2558) by Thai Airways International Public Company Limited flight number TG 970 and will return by Thai Airways International Public Company Limited flight number TG 931, scheduled to arrive at Suvarnabhumi Airport, Samut Prakan Province, on Thursday, 26th of November, B.E. 2558 (2015) at 06.25 hours.
