Concerning the Royal Visit of
Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn
to the People's Republic of China

Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn will pay a Royal Visit to the People's Republic of China from 4th to 11th of April, B.E. 2560 (2017).

During the Visit, Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn will witness the signing of the following Memoranda of Understanding: first, Memorandum of Understanding between the National Astronomical Research Institute of Thailand (Public Organization) and the National Astronomical Observatories of China; second, Memorandum of Understanding for Collaboration between the Office of the Civil Service Commission of Thailand and University of Chinese Academy of Sciences on the development of personnel in the fields of sciences and technology; third, Memorandum of Understanding on Academic and Research Cooperation between the Institute of High Energy Physics of China and Suranaree University of Technology, Chulalongkorn University, and the National Astronomical Research Institute of Thailand; fourth and last, Memorandum of Understanding for Collaboration between the Institute of High Energy Physics of China and All Member Institutions of the JUNO Collaboration on the JUNO Experiment.

Moreover on this Visit, Her Royal Highness will preside over the Opening Ceremony of the new office building of the Royal Thai Consulate-General in Shanghai and will also visit places of special interest and observe activities in various institutions as appropriate.

Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn will depart from Suvarnabhumi Airport, Samut Prakan Province, on Tuesday, 4th of April, B.E. 2560 (2017) at 10.15 hours by Thai Airways International Public Company Limited flight number TG 618, and will return by Thai Airways International Public Company Limited flight number TG 665, scheduled to arrive at Suvarnabhumi Airport, Samut Prakan Province, on Tuesday, 11th of April, B.E. 2560 (2017) at 21.00 hours.
